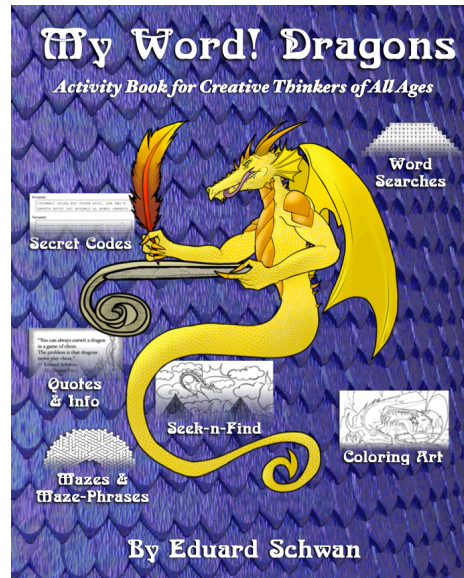
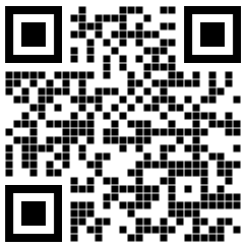

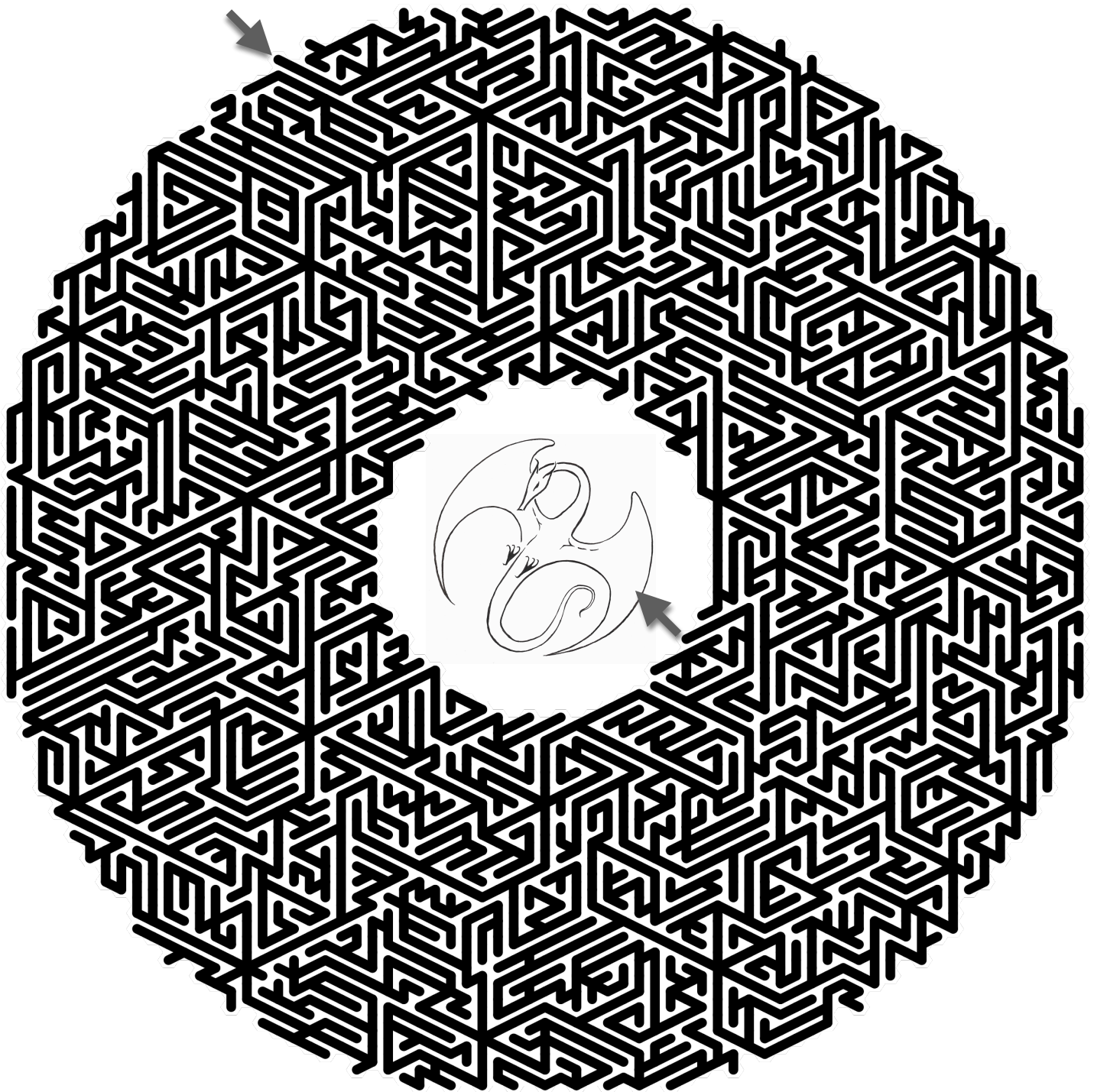

# Dragon's Maze

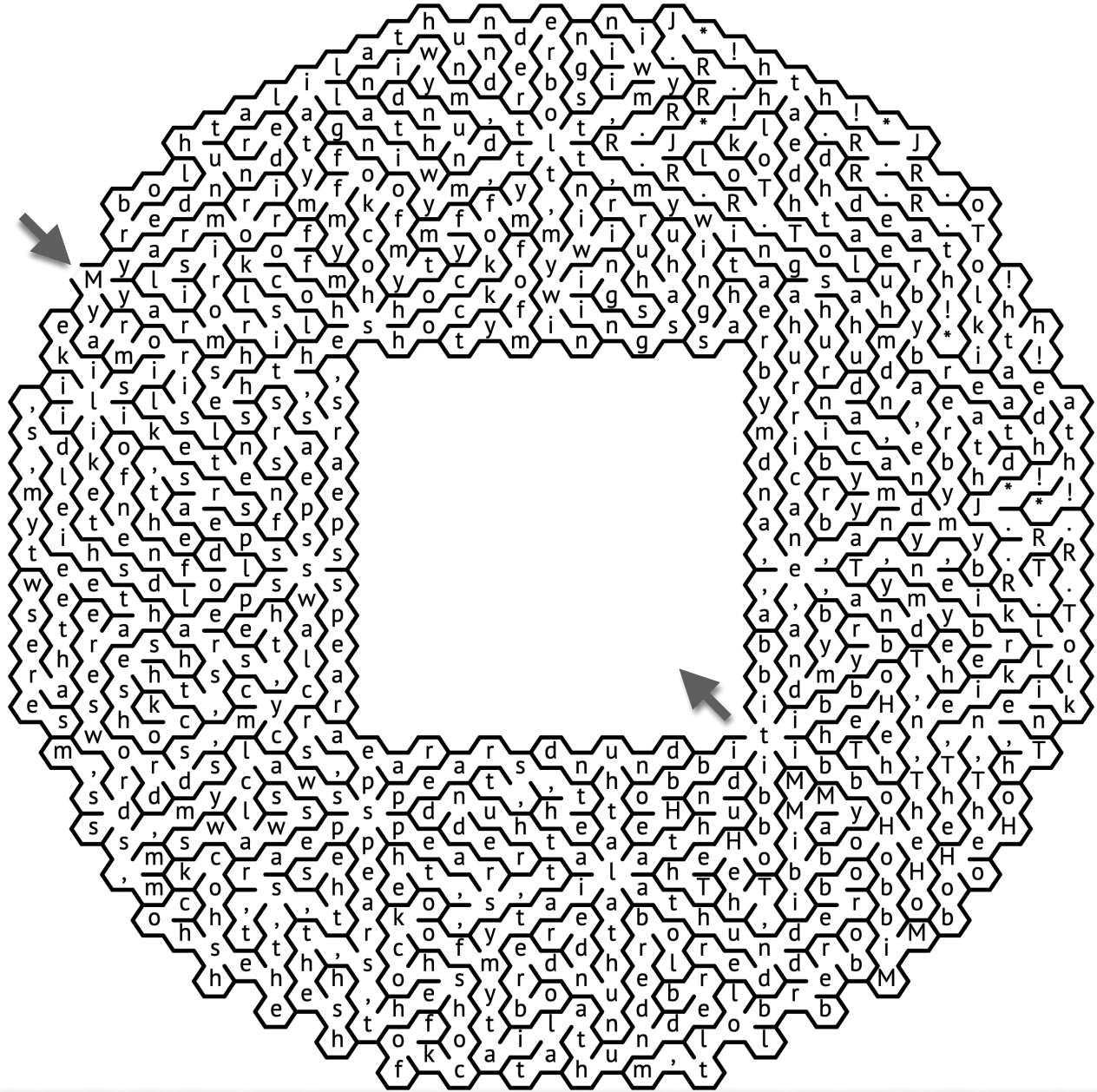
Start at the “in” arrow, and follow the dark path through the maze to the “out” arrow.
